Project Overview:

Pacific Mobile Structures partnered with the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife to deliver a SAGE Conference Room and Training Facility in Yakima, Washington. The project consists of a 28x38 building made up of two modules and was built in collaboration with Blazer and designed with Portland State University. Delivered through KCDA Cooperative Purchasing, the facility expands on-site capacity for meetings, training sessions, and administrative support.

The customer needed a dedicated conference space along with an ancillary training area to better support staff operations and programming. The project supports a new location tied to Fish and Wildlife operations, where the existing building could no longer accommodate growing space needs. A SAGE building was selected because it provided a turnkey modular solution with an elevated focus on occupant health, comfort, and long-term performance. Pacific Mobile Structures completed full site work and installation, delivering a ready-to-use facility that met both functional and scheduling needs.

The SAGE approach, Smart Academic Green Environment, is central to the design and elevates this building beyond a standard modular solution. It emphasizes improved indoor air quality, abundant natural daylighting, and material selections that support healthier and more productive spaces. The result is a training and conference environment designed to better support staff collaboration, learning, and daily operations.

The facility was placed to support Fish and Wildlife operations at a new Yakima location, providing much-needed additional space while integrating efficiently into the surrounding site.
